SCA is responsible for maintaining the defibrillator and former telephone kiosk in East Saltoun. We are pleased to report that a number of local residents have received training in resuscitation and use of defibrillators.

Dial 999 in an emergency to get the code that opens the secure cabinet inside the phone box. You can then remove the small carry case that is hanging up, take it where it is needed and unzip the defibrillator which will "talk" you through using it. It has been used a few times and is helping save lives in our community.

Fletcher Hall Maintenance

Essential maintenance of the Hall has continued, including recent air monitoring testing and structural engineer's checks of the temporary supports to the south end gable wall.

We continue to keep a close eye on the roof, structure and finishes, with assistance from East Lothian Council and would also like to thank them for filling the potholes in within the car oark with left over tar from the newly laid pavement in front of the hall. Current electrical work includes repair of some overhead heaters and replacement of fluorescent lights in the main hall with more efficient LED lights.

Fletcher Hall Modernisation

With the financial pressures facing local authorities, East Lothian Council has withdrawn the capital funds it allocated to assist hall redevelopment in 2016. This is disappointing but does not change the position the trustees had previously reached – that the grant (conditional on us implementing requirements for school use) fell well short of covering the additional costs we would incur.

With huge inflation in building prices in recent years – but no increase in the 2016 allocation - the shortfall in meeting the Council's conditions would be increased considerably more. The ongoing use of the Hall and its longer-term future continue to be our top priorities, although it remains extremely challenging to find a solution to sourcing the levels of funding required to replace the building.

We are always grateful to receive fundraising ideas as well as volunteers to assist our small number of committee members in organising community events. We currently have around 50 registered Members from our local community and are always happy to receive further applications. Registering for membership of our SCIO costs you nothing but it gives you the opportunity to attend occasional meetings, to elect the committee annually, and to vote on any other matters concerning the use and future of Fletcher Hall.
